Renewal of the Electoral Roll

Notice is hereby given that under the Church Representation Rules a new Church Electoral Roll is being prepared. All persons who wish to have their names entered on the new roll, **whether their names are entered on the present roll or not**, are requested to **apply for enrolment not later than 15 March 2019**.

The new roll will come into operation on **16 March 2019**.

Forms of application for enrolment can be obtained from the undersigned. In order to be entitled to attend the annual chaplaincy meeting on 31 March 2019 and to take part in its proceedings, **forms of application for enrolment must be received by 15 March 2019**.

Under the Constitution of this Diocese any persons are entitled to have their names entered on the roll, if they:

- Are baptized.
- Are a lay person.
- Are at least 16 years old.
- Are a member of the Church of England (or of a Church in communion with the Church of England) whose name is entered on the electoral roll of a parish or chaplaincy in the Provinces of Canterbury or York.
- Are a member of the Church of England (or a Church in communion with the Church of England) and have habitually attended public worship in the congregation during the last six months.
- Are a member in good standing of a Church not in communion with the Church of England that subscribes to the doctrine of the Holy Trinity and declares themselves to be a member of the Church of England and have habitually attended public worship in the chaplaincy during the last six months.
- Have signed a form of application for enrolment.

Any error discovered in the roll following publication should at once be reported to the undersigned.
