



Covid Measures and guidelines at La Côte Anglican Church

Update 13 January 2022

For your safety and reassurance, we have a small working group following the Covid situation on a daily basis, and with council we are assessing our approach on a regular basis. Here are our updated guidelines for worship at La Côte Church:

1. **If you have been in contact with anyone who has tested positive with Covid**, please ensure you have a negative lateral flow test, before attending services.
2. **We are limiting the numbers in both churches so that we are approximately 1/2 rather than 2/3 capacity.** Thus, we will aim to welcome a maximum of 80 in Gingins and 40 in Divonne and 130 in Crassier.
3. **Pre-register with Liz** – both for contact tracing and so that we do not have to turn people away at the door because we are too many.
4. **Please bring your 2G Covid Pass and ID.** If you have not registered, we will take your contact details purely for contact tracing.
5. **Please wear masks at all times** over your nose and mouth. When taking part in communion, please wait until you are sitting down to remove your mask and consume the holy bread.
6. **Please sanitise your hands**
7. **Please ensure social distancing when you are in the church** – and we would ask you to keep social distances outside.
8. **For the time being we will not serve refreshments after our services** – we encourage the wearing of masks even outside when you gather after the service.
9. **To help keep our community safe**, we encourage following the WHO advice on participating in the vaccination programme. This includes booster vaccination, which is available in our region.
