Background Information: The Ignatian Way Day was initiated by Louis Christiaens S.J. in 1996. Louis (1935–2024) was a Catholic priest of the Society of Jesus, a religious order founded by Saint Ignatius of Loyola, also known as the Jesuits. In 2018 Fr. Louis asked Stephen Claffey to take responsibility for facilitating the Ignatian Way Day, which is held three times a year and is open to people from all walks of life. Stephen, a deeply engaged pilgrim on the holy journey of life since his teens, draws on a good knowledge of Christian spirituality and psychology (PhD). He first met Fr. Louis in 1999 and benefitted from Fr. Louis's guidance over many years. Stephen and close collaborators from diverse churches prepare each retreat day with the desire that all who come may experience God's personal love and inner peace amid a welcoming community.
