A looming disaster, a serious threat to the Pays de Gex and the Lake Geneva region

The Canton of Vaud plans to create a colossal landfill at "Tattes-de-Bogis" over 10 years. Just steps from the French border, between Chavannes-des-Bois and Chavannes-de-Bogis, this 45-hectare site (the size of 65 football fields) would sit right above the Versoix/Divonne river, which runs through the Pays de Gex before flowing into Lake Geneva.

Why should France be worried?

- Irreversible pollution of the Tattes-de-Bogis and river: Type A and B waste (the latter includes bonded asbestos, bituminous materials, vitrified residues) will directly threaten water quality, biodiversity, and ecosystems shared by France and Switzerland.
- Unbearable traffic across the border: 132 round trips by 40-tonne trucks every single day (one every 4 minutes!) coming from Lausanne and Geneva, overloading motorway, roads, and villages impacting French villages like Sauverny, Grilly, and Divonne-les-Bains...
- Degradation of our quality of life with devastating impacts on the landscape: destruction of natural areas, constant noise, dust, air and water pollution, increased road safety hazards the very things that make our Franco-Swiss region unique will be under direct threat.

Why act now?

Following 10 years of silence, the Canton of Vaud has quietly launched a public consultation from 8 July to 19 September 2025, conveniently timed during the summer holidays. It is vital that residents of the Pays de Gex and the wider Lake Geneva region take action to protect their environment and quality of life. Also insist that your local authorities take a stand!
