Join *Spirituality and Management*, an oecomenical discussion group for managers and professionals who lead a team of employees or volunteers or who manage stakeholders.

Being a formal or informal leader is a great responsibility. Choices, ambiguities and dilemmas can be sources of stress. It is therefore helpful to have the opportunity to reflect in a concrete yet values-driven way in order to discover how to face these challenges.

The group offers participants such a safe space for reflection and contemplation, helping them to align their professional practice with their Christian values. Each session will draw inspiration from biblical and other Christian texts. The goal of this peer discussion is to learn and receive advice and support from one another.

We meet once a month online to recharge, gain clarity on one's work responsibilities, and build resilience in the face of challenges. Active participation from everyone during the sessions is required to achieve practical and useful results.
